

ETHICAL CODE OF PARTY MEMBERS

Ethics is a public matter (thing) about what is allowed, what is necessary, and what is prohibited.

Ethics is the external image of a moral person who creates a moral society.

By declaring ethics as the foundation of our business conduct, we take on a powerful moral obligation. The principle of trust is of utmost importance for the development of our Party. The culture of actions undoubtedly relies on the observance of laws, regulations, and the Party's Charter, but it also depends on the understanding of the values proclaimed in the Party's Program. This Code serves as a guide that sets the coordinates for all our activities and protects the Party from any usurpation.

The Party and its members adhere to the following moral principles:

- One may disagree with a person's position, but one should express themselves regarding the position, not the person.
- Respect for rights and freedoms: Exclude actions and statements that may lead to the infringement of human rights and freedoms, be accountable for spoken words, and avoid statements that demean people's dignity.
- Respect for people: Treat people and their problems with respect and attention, help them in protecting their rights, restoring justice, and overcoming difficult life situations.
- Political struggle is a struggle of ideas, not people: One may disagree with a person's position, but one should express themselves regarding the position, not the person.
- Open discussion: Openly express and defend one's position during party discussions, and after making a final decision, adhere to the collegial party position.



- Fulfillment of obligations: Fulfill the commitments made to people, personally and regularly report on the fulfillment of orders, promises, citizens' appeals, and the implementation of election programs.
- Personal modesty: Adhere to the principle of personal modesty and restraint in public behavior.
- Protection of honor and reputation: In response to public accusations of illegal or immoral actions, publicly defend one's honor, dignity, and reputation by all legal means. If the accusations of crimes or misconduct are true and discredit the Party, immediately resign from all party positions.
- When fulfilling the mission, a Party member adheres to the Charter, internal documents, and standards of the Party's actions.
- Every Party member respects their members, ensures democratic governance, adheres to the principles of leadership and employee responsibility, and responds to their misconduct.
- The Party, as a civic association, considers the involvement of people in voluntary activities a priority of civil society.
- Consistently strive for skillful activity, professionalism, and excellence to achieve the best work results and public recognition.
- Receiving funds for its activities from donors and benefactors, the Party respects their interests and uses the received funds purposefully.
- Show courage in the fight against social injustice.
- In case of incompetence and disregard for the principles of justice in laws and other legal acts, the Party works to change them.
- Do not use or promote violence to express opinions, achieve goals, or attract public attention.
- To achieve its goals, use natural, human, and spiritual resources, as well as material and property means economically and rationally, considering the needs of today's and future generations.
- The Party adheres to good traditions of financing, budget justification, and transparency, and avoids double financing.



- The Party provides a report and is accountable for achieving goals and the methods and means used for this to its founders, donors, benefactors, and the public.
- The Party considers readiness for accountability important, which is ensured by skillful leadership, internal reporting, and adherence to good accounting traditions.
- The Party will publish a report on its activities and a financial report at least once a year.
- Information about the mission, membership, activities, and financing of the Party's activities should be open and understandable.
- Communicate with everyone openly and directly, do not act anonymously.
- The Party is open to new ideas and different opinions, as well as to cooperation to achieve common goals.

Independence and prevention of conflict of interest.

- The Party is independent in setting goals, making decisions, and actions, and avoids falling under the influence of public institutions or private enterprises when the independence of civil associations, their independence, and ability to act in the public interest is lost.
- The Party and its members prevent conflicts of interest. In the event of a conflict of interest, the Party takes the necessary measures to eliminate it.

Faithfulness to one's word and recognition of authorship of ideas.

- Adhere to both written and oral agreements and contracts.
- Respect the authorship and ownership of ideas and projects of other individuals and associations.
- Recognize differences in ways of thinking, the diversity of associations, and their goals.
- Do not defame other associations, their members, and their opinions.
- Be ready to always answer questions about the purpose and meaning of life, about fate and necessity, about freedom and happiness.





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
