We are an active part of Ukrainian society, and the glory of our ancestors goes back centuries. We overcame the "peaceful atom" in 1986 and still owe the heroes of that time. We chose our Motherland in 1991 and have never changed our choice. We stood against usurpation in 2013 and went to war in 2014. We stood in lines for weapons in 2022 and stopped the Russian invasion. We fight and spend our lives, we create and give birth for Victory. We need and demand - **the Republic of Ukraine must be OURS!**

We are witnessing the destruction of the old World with its helpless and weak institutions. We understand that a global confrontation of Freedom and Creativity against Fear and Control is taking place.



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The ideas of individual Freedom, a compassionate and charitable society, and a limited government with a system of checks and balances **have shaped Western civilization**. However, the ideas of the "tyranny of the majority," where the rights of the individual are subordinated to the interests **of a repressive government chosen by citizens**, have led to moral decay and social division. The direct proponents of the ideology of the "tyranny of the majority" are Marxism, fascism, and socialism, which still persist today and are vividly manifested in Ukraine.

We believe that the Western world and Ukraine cannot continue down this path and must return to their roots. **Ukraine's mission in this is to become a Home of Freedom**, an example, and a place where a new Renaissance begins.

We believe that a person is created individually free, is the master of their own destiny, has morals, and the ability to understand the consequences of their actions. But **freedom without responsibility corrupts the individual**. Responsible human freedom (will) gives rise to the right to actions, and the individual is solely responsible for them.

Without ownership, a person is unable to realize their right to personal freedom. The state's removal of a person's responsibility for their life and family leads to the degeneration of the individual and the destruction of society. The family, in which we care for our spouse, children, and parents, is the fundamental basis of society. A person is endowed with feelings of morality and compassion.

No one can be forced into charity; people act only by their goodwill. State-provided charity deprives people of the opportunity to express goodwill and leads to a decline in public morality. If society is immoral, the state will also be immoral.

People who are guided by common interests unite into communities. The combination of such associations forms society. It is the presence of such voluntary public structures that forms the fabric of society. Religion, education, sports, science, art, and much more are the most important functions of a free society and should be separated from the state.



The Republic of Ukraine was essentially created by the ruling communist class at that time. Therefore, the adopted Constitution consisted of socialist slogans, which, over 30 years, have proven ineffective, ultimately leading to the threat of losing statehood.

We believe that the sole role of the Constitution is to describe the structure of the republic, limit the powers of its governing institutions, and protect the natural rights of individuals. The powers of the central government should be limited to defense, international representation, issuance of a stable currency, and oversight of constitutional order. To uphold and protect property rights, people establish a fair court, which includes the institution of juries.

A society of self-sufficient and moral people requires only a limited government, which means self-financed and self-governed local and regional authorities, independent of each other and the central government—**this is what will truly make Ukraine a republic.**

All productive members of society should pay taxes equally and under the same conditions. Unearned wealth kills personal motivation, public morality, and economic competition. Therefore, no government should redistribute any property from person to person or from region to region.

The right to vote, granted to a person who does not understand the consequences of their political position or does not bear responsibility for the consequences of their choice, leads to the decline of society. **Voting is a right determined by the payment of taxes, protection of the common state, and verified knowledge of the constitution.**

Economic freedom is the source of well-being for both individuals and society as a whole. A person has the opportunity to realize themselves in the free market through the fruits of their labor. Everything that is not prohibited is allowed.



Economics is the voluntary exchange of goods and services between free market participants. Just as the government cannot interfere in private relationships, it cannot interfere in economic relations. The government cannot own the means of production or become a subject of the free market. The government is unable to regulate the free market. The government, represented by specific officials, bears both political and criminal responsibility for the functional decisions made or not made.

We must, based on the above, conclude a social contract and adopt it as a new Constitution: a Constitution on which the new Ukraine will be built—a republic that generations of Ukrainians have been striving for.



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
