Introduction

We, the active part of Ukrainian society, known as the descendants of the glorious Cossacks who embodied the people's aspirations for freedom and an independent republic.

We create and protect. We stood up for the defence of Europe when the world learned about the Chernobyl tragedy in 1986, opposed usurpation in 2013, and went to war in 2014. We stood in lines for weapons and dragged ammunition from half the world in 2022. We pay money and fight, we create and give birth. We need and demand - the country of Ukraine must be ours!

We are witnesses to the destruction of part of the Old World with its helpless and weak institutions. We understand that a global confrontation between Freedom and Fear and Control is taking place. And we realize that, just as a thousand years ago, we stand on the edge between Freedom and Slavery, between Good and Evil, between Light and Darkness.



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Ideas of individual freedom, charitable civil society, and limited government created Western civilization. The proclaimed political equality of rights in their libertarian and especially institutional approach created social mobility, leading to the socio-economic prosperity of society. However, the ideas of "tyranny of the majority" through a government elected by passive masses, where individual rights are subordinated to the interests of a repressive government, lead to moral degradation, social division, and demographic problems.

The direct proponents of the ideology of the "tyranny of the majority" are Marxism, Fascism, and Socialism, which have led governments to exterminate tens of millions of people. This inhumane experiment continues in Ukraine. This ideology is always masked under "government for the people", "social protection", "inclusiveness", and ultimately "we are all presidents". But their actions and results speak for themselves.

We must recognize that Ukraine, which has great natural and intellectual potential, should not continue down this criminal path of national degradation. We must return to our roots, as Ukraine's mission is to become a Haven of Freedom, an example, and a place where a new cultural, social, and economic Renaissance begins.

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Our Program

1. Constitution from our hearts.

We have repeatedly witnessed how the ruling class, after suffering defeat and collapse, sought salvation from us—the active civic part of society. From those they restricted, exploited, and despised. We remember February 2022 all too well, when this class, instead of the promised barbecues for the masses, handed out machine guns and grenade launchers from trucks, abolished extortionate taxes and duties, and stopped the racket of inspections and permits.

This was the unwritten social contract they offered us. We accepted it and repelled the enemy, surprising the whole world. But as soon as they were convinced that Ukraine would not fall, that contract was thrown into the trash. The "Ukrainian paper army" and Soviet-style governance once again became the norm of power. And what do we have now: disarmament of citizens and pressure on volunteers, pressure from the tax authorities, customs, and law enforcement agencies, increased fines, and a rise in criminal cases for political persecution.

1.1. Responsibility and consent generate rights.

The right to vote, granted to an individual who does not understand the consequences of their political position or does not take responsibility for the consequences of their choice, leads to the decline of society.

Voting is a right conditioned upon the payment of taxes (or civic contributions to General Projects) and verified knowledge of the Constitution or its equivalents.

The governance of the Republic is based on the self-governance of competent individuals who take responsibility by paying taxes (fees, tariffs) and serving in the armed forces. The rule that the right to representation in government is exclusively based on the payment of taxes and military duty must be strictly observed (a debatable issue).

1.2. Rights: Individual – Family – Community – Republic of Ukraine.

We believe that a person is inherently free. They are the master of their destiny, possess morals, and have the ability to understand the consequences of their actions. But freedom without responsibility corrupts the individual. Responsible freedom (Will) grants the right to act, and individuals are solely accountable for their actions. A person is endowed with countless



rights, including the right to life, the fruits of their labour, and the pursuit of happiness. **Without ownership, a person cannot realize their right to personal freedom.**

Only individuals are responsible for their lives. When the government relieves individuals of responsibility for their lives and families, it leads to the degradation of the individual and the destruction of society. By nature, people have good morals and empathy. No one can be coerced into charity; people act only of their own free will. Government-provided charity deprives people of the opportunity to exercise goodwill and leads to a decline in good morals. The government should not assume the role of a benefactor. If society lacks common good, the government will also lack common good and will not be capable of honest charity. Keep your agreements. Do no harm.

A free person does not need double permission from the authorities to travel abroad. If a citizen's passport confirms their citizenship and identifies their name and surname, then what does the "foreign" passport confirm? The system of "foreign" passports should be abolished, eliminating double identification of individuals.

The family, in which we care for our spouse, children, and parents, is the fundamental foundation of society. Guided by goodwill, people take care of those who cannot care for themselves—orphans, childless elderly people, and people with disabilities.

A citizen without a Community is an imperial nonsense. Only the union of active members of society into communities makes a person a citizen, and the union of communities in a territory creates a Republic.

2. Limited Republic – Formation of Legislative and Executive Branches of Power

2.1. All political power in Ukraine originates from the citizens and Communities with the aim of realizing the interests of the citizens and Communities; therefore, all government bodies should be established through elections by the citizens with agreed-upon powers.

2.2. Since Ukrainians as a Political Nation consist of citizens of Ukraine of all nationalities, we propose a professional discussion on acquiring citizenship status and immigration policy in Ukraine: who is a Citizen and who is not; how to become a Citizen of Ukraine.

2.3. We believe that the sole role of the Republic of Ukraine is to protect the natural rights of the individual citizen and the Rights of Communities. A society of self-sufficient and good-hearted people needs only a limited Government. Limited government means self-financing



self-governing local and regional authorities that are independent of each other and the central government, to which only those functions are delegated that cannot be performed privately, corporately, or communally (at the Community level).

2.4. Any government consists of ambitious people who will always strive for the usurpation of power. To prevent this, a system of checks and balances, enshrined in the Constitution, must be created. We believe that the sole role of the Constitution is to describe the structure of the Republic and limit its powers.

2.5. The powers of the central government are limited to: defence, international representation, issuance of stable currency, and general oversight of constitutional order. The government should provide for the citizens of the country only those important functions that cannot be performed by individuals, private institutions, or local communities.

2.6. The existing Verkhovna Rada (historical name) **should consist of a bicameral mutually vetoing parliament:** the House of Communities and the Senate. No decision of the Verkhovna Rada has force until it is confirmed by both Houses.

2.7. Senators are elected for a term of 6 years, two senators from each region and large City. Elections for half of the Senate are held every 3 years.

2.8. Deputies of the House of Communities are elected for a term of 3 years. The House of Communities has the right to veto budget allocations.

2.9. All official business in the republican government bodies (from the community to the parliament) is conducted in the Ukrainian language. In courts, public life, and everyday activities, parties are free to choose their language of communication.

3. President, Prime Minister.

We must establish a social contract and adopt it as a new Constitution—the Constitution on which the new Ukrainian Republic will be realized—the state that generations of Ukrainians have aspired to.

President or Prime Minister? This is a question that should be resolved through a constitutional process initiated by the Party, leading to the adoption of a new Constitution, where the fate of these positions and their powers will be determined.



4. Administrative-Territorial Division and Organization of Elections.

4.1. The formation of government and administrative-territorial structure are interconnected. In the future – an administrative reform and a return to the historical division of Ukrainian Lands, rather than Stalin's artificial "regions".

4.2. The basic level is the UTC (United Territorial Communities), a city without district division, a district in cities with district division. They are formed by the corresponding communities and financed according to the relevant list of taxes.

4.3. Districts in a region consist of UTCs and cities without district division. At the district level, the organization of local police, medical care, and education is ensured. Electoral districts are created for elections to the House of Communities.

4.4. Cities with district division have the status of "Large City" and have functions similar to districts formed by a combination of UTCs.

4.5. Regions are formed by the union of districts and "Large Cities" and have representation in the Senate. The financing of the region is carried out through transfers from the UTCs. The region elects a representative governing body.

4.6. The head of the region and the Mayor of a city with district division are elected on a majoritarian basis.

5. Electoral Rights

5.1. We advocate for the right of every citizen who has reached the age of 18 to make a choice about their role in participating or not participating in political decisions regarding the election of the country's leadership and the ability to be elected to government bodies, as well as being mobilized into the army in case of foreign invasion.

5.2. If a citizen agrees to be an active member of society, they gain the right to vote in elections and be elected to republican institutions of power and positions in the UTC (deputies in parliament, President, referendum). They also have the obligation to pay mandatory taxes and to be mobilized to defend the country.

5.3. If a citizen does not agree to be an active member of society, participate in elections, and be mobilized, they do not pay direct taxes. If they engage in entrepreneurial activity, they pay only the established fixed taxes to the local budget. In the event of martial law, they may participate in the construction of defensive structures with mandatory wage payment. Such a citizen also has the right to free movement abroad during martial law.

6. Land, Natural Resources, and Subsoil

6.1. Land, natural resources, and subsoil are special commodities. They are commodities because effective use of anything is impossible without a private owner. Accordingly, land can be privately, collectively, communally, and generally republican-owned. They are special because these commodities cannot be alienated to foreign citizens or other countries, and their use affects the rights and freedoms of other citizens.

6.2. In the legislation on land, subsoil, and natural resources, all possible legal forms of lease and its derivative forms should be used.

7. International Relations

7.1. A number of international structures and supranational organizations created in the 20th century have shown their inability to solve the issues for which they were created. A review of all relations with such structures is required: UN, NATO, EU, WHO, Red Cross, OSCE, UNESCO, UNICEF.

7.2. The main strategic partners of Ukraine should remain the USA, the United Kingdom, and other Common Law countries.

7.3. Our priorities are the creation of new security structures with those countries that have truly sided with our citizens since the beginning of the Russian invasion of Ukraine. We are open to creating new structures and interstate alliances, primarily with our true allies:

- **Poland**, which was the first to open its borders to our citizens and accepted the largest number of them, which understands the real danger of Russia and therefore quickly provided assistance with weapons;
- **The United Kingdom**, which, in addition to providing weapons, trains our soldiers and has provided shelter to more than 100,000 Ukrainian citizens;
- **The Baltic countries** (Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia) and Scandinavia (Finland, Sweden, Norway, Denmark);
- **Eastern European countries** (Moldova, Romania, Czech Republic, Bulgaria, Slovakia); these countries have taken a clear stance on Russia's actions against Ukraine and provide comprehensive assistance to the Armed Forces of Ukraine.



7.4. We need special relations with Israel, as a republic with which we have close historical and human ties, as well as with a people who have similar values and needs in protecting their independence. **7.5.** The historical necessity and mutual benefit of partnership relations with Turkey, which plays an important role in the region as a leader of the Sunni and Turkic world, have been proven.

7.6. We distinguish between the actions of the Belarusian authorities and the attitude of the Belarusian people towards Russia's aggression against Ukraine. We fully support the aspirations of the Belarusian people to overthrow the current regime.

7.7. We are open to friendly relations with the people of Hungary and do not identify them with the government, which openly supports Russia with its actions.

7.8. We support those Russians who are fighting against the current Russian regime.

7.9. We support the free movement of people, goods, and services in Europe and a visa-free regime with all EU countries. We advocate for reasonable migration rules that should not harm the cultural customs existing in Ukraine.

8. Defence and Internal Security

8.1. National security and defence are the highest priorities. Conducting a broad reform of the Ukrainian army in accordance with NATO standards and the best examples (Israel, Switzerland, USA) of organizing armed forces.

8.2. The party advocates for the creation of a professional army, territorial defence forces, and a system and forces of civil defence.

8.3. We support the free possession and carrying of short-barreled and long-barreled firearms among citizens recognized as capable, for the purpose of self-defence, protection of property, family, and country.

8.4. All citizens with the right to vote have the right to private ownership of any types of weapons and military equipment in accordance with the agreed nomenclature.

8.5. We believe that military service is a conscious duty of a citizen of Ukraine. At the same time, a citizen has the right to refuse military service at the cost of losing their right to vote and be elected to any government bodies and local community management bodies.

8.6. Internal security is ensured by the following formations:



- Police – at the level of villages, cities, districts, and regions, which is elected by the respective territorial communities;
- Security Service of Ukraine (SBU) – requires reform and specification of tasks, excluding interference in the economic relations of business entities;
- Main Intelligence Directorate (GUR) – requires reform through structural optimization.

8.7. The SBU and GUR should not engage in political persecution and should be accountable to the relevant committee in the Senate.

9. Reforms (transformation, change, restructuring of any aspect of social life (orders, institutions, establishments), not destroying the foundations of the existing social structure).

9.1. Pension Reform

9.1.1. The state pension fund as an instrument of social protection has been completely discredited by abuses by state officials and therefore must be gradually liquidated. Its resources and structures are transferred to local communities at the basic level proportionally.

9.1.2. Since the nationwide privatization using privatization property certificates was completed on 01.05.1999, we believe that the state's obligations to pay pensions remain for those citizens of Ukraine who were 18 years old as of 01.05.1999 (i.e., those born before 01.05.1981).

9.1.3. For citizens born after 01.05.1981, it is proposed to develop a separate pension support program in the form of an unconditional basic income (UBI) or a republican Share (RS). Pension issues for such people are resolved at the level of the United Territorial Communities (UTC).

9.2. Medical Reform

9.2.1. At the expense of the republican share from the exploitation of public property of the Republic at the level of Communities, the following is ensured:

- basic level of medical care provision;
- accessible and quality medicine based on the principles of family medicine;
- introduction of insurance medicine;
- creation of a transparent and responsible pharmaceutical market.

9.3. Educational Reform

9.3.1. At the expense of the republican share from the exploitation of public property of the Republic at the level of Communities, the following is ensured:



- provision of free basic education;
- development of private educational and scientific institutions;
- audit and revision of the functions of the institutes of the Academy of Sciences of Ukraine. Academicians must be publicly recognized in the world.

9.3.2. We consider the reform of healthcare and education to be the most important and priority tasks for the country. At the same time, we oppose government interference in the further regulation of these basic systems of civil society. Academicians must be publicly recognized in the world.

9.4. Tax Reform

9.4.1. All productive members of society must pay taxes in equal shares and on equal terms. Unearned income kills personal motivation, public morals, and economic competition. Therefore, no government should redistribute any property from person to person or from region to region.

9.4.2. Local taxes – UTC/districts in cities with district division/cities without district division (basic administrative level).

- **Budget-forming level for regions** – UTC-cities without districts and cities with district division. From this level, the listed administrative levels are financed. Details of tax legislation are fixed in the relevant laws adopted by the legislative body. Local taxes include:

- **Property tax (including land fees)** – if you own property in the community – you use services – you pay.

- **Unified Social Tax/Pension/Unemployment tax.** The pension fund is transferred to the community (distributed among them proportionally to the sources of formation). The amount of the tax is determined by the local community, the entire amount of the tax goes to the place of registration of the payer in a specific community. Citizens with the right to vote pay.

- **Personal income tax.** The amount of the tax is determined at the national level, the entire amount of the tax goes to the place of registration of the payer in a specific Community. Citizens with the right to vote pay.

- **Rent payments** – payment for the use of common resources.

9.4.3. National taxes

- VAT – is eliminated.
- Corporate income tax/Individual Entrepreneur tax – is eliminated.



- Environmental tax is canceled. For violation of environmental standards – large fines, which go to the budget of the district administration where the violation was committed.
- Sales tax is introduced. Collected through the banking system for non-retail trade. For retail trade – through cash registers.
- Withdrawn capital tax is introduced. Enterprises are registered centrally in a "single window".
- Excise taxes and duties (if any).

9.4.4. Simplified taxation system for self-employed citizens – Individual Entrepreneurs (IE).

- Elimination of three forms, unified rules for all IEs.
- Doubling the existing size of the non-taxable turnover for IEs.
- Elimination of restrictions for IEs to work with any other forms of business and regulatory authorities.

9.5. Customs

9.5.1. Complete abolition of duties, permits, and any documents for the import of any goods and technologies of military or dual-use. Bonus duty (payment to the importer from the budget) for the import of all-wheel-drive pickups, trucks, and engineering equipment of military or dual-use. Removal of any environmental and other restrictions on the import and use of this equipment in civilian life.

9.5.2. Protection of the Ukrainian manufacturer is not resolved through customs levers. The function of customs is to impose a sales tax on imports.

9.6. Economic

9.6.1. We are convinced supporters of a market economy. The government should not manage the economy manually.

9.6.2. Economic freedom is the source of the well-being of the individual and society as a whole. A person has the opportunity to realize themselves in the free market thanks to the fruits of their labour. Everything that is not prohibited is allowed.

9.6.3. The economy is a voluntary exchange of goods and services between free market participants. Just as the government cannot interfere in private relations, it cannot interfere in economic relations. The government cannot own the means of production or become a subject of the free market. The government is unable to regulate the free market (in this case, it would not be free). The consideration of financial and economic disputes by the government takes place through the judicial system.



9.6.4. Implementation of a simple transparent procedure for registering a new business within a few hours with simultaneous inclusion in all necessary registers and the application of the rule – the business engages in any activities a priori (without inclusion in the Charter) based on declaration, except for a small list of those types that are subject to licensing (for example, weapons and medicines), which in turn will be carried out on transparent grounds.

9.7. Judicial

9.7.1. To observe and protect property rights, people create an elective fair court. Judges are elected on general grounds from among citizens who have the right to vote and be elected.

9.7.2. The court is an independent party to the judicial process, which operates on the principles of adversarial proceedings.

9.7.3. A jury trial is introduced. Judges are subject to lustration.

9.7.4. The presumption of innocence is a direct-action norm for citizens.

9.7.5. The prosecutor is an elected state prosecutor in the absence of a plaintiff.

9.7.6. The penitentiary system is not punitive but performs the function of limiting the ability of offenders to commit crimes. It should also be a mechanism for enforcing contracts.

9.7.7. The institution of private marshals is introduced to search for defendants released on bail or convicts who are wanted for a reward.

9.7.8. It is necessary to establish administrative and criminal liability for non-compliance and violation of the Constitution and laws of Ukraine, which does not exist today. Currently, there is no responsibility for this. That is why today Ukrainian society has received the irresponsibility of the authorities before society and the usurpation of power.

9.7.9. The problem of creating a fair judicial system cannot be reduced only to the replacement of personalities, since, as practice has shown, people change under the influence of power and big money for the worse. The technology of the judicial process itself must change to ensure the independence of judges, their inviolability on the one hand, and on the other – their assessment of activities, on which their well-being and guarantee of continued activity will depend. The general vector of development is Common Law based on the example of the USA and the UK.

10. Demography and Migration.

- Birth support program;
- Encouraging the return of citizens;
- Development of preschool institutions;
- Encouraging professional migration (migrants must provide objective information about themselves, indicate their experience and the work they intend to perform from the proposed list. The community to which the migrant will be sent at the request of the Community provides housing, work, and training in the Ukrainian language. After 3-5 years of conscientious work and the corresponding petition of the Community, the migrant can apply for citizenship and after 5 years agree or refuse the right to vote and be elected to government bodies).

11. Three stages of Program implementation.

In the first stage (up to 6 months):

- Judicial system reboot;
- Tax, customs, and economic reforms;
- Introduction of the constitutional process;
- Change in the functioning of the military-industrial complex on private terms.

In the second stage (up to 12 months):

- Pension, medical, and educational reforms;
- Administrative-territorial division;
- Adoption of a new Constitution;
- Audit of natural and land resources.

In the third stage (up to 3 years):

- Conclusion of a military alliance;
- Monitoring of government activities;
- Republican program for the development of space technologies;
- Creation of conditions for the existence of offshore zones and techno parks.

12. Final theses.

We act as a platform for uniting proactive forces, both individuals and organizations, which will give meaning and strength to the renewal of the Party.

The program will be adjusted based on people's feedback and real changes in circumstances.





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
